

Most Utah Counties are in **Moderate** Level of COVID19 Transmission:

Masks are required in all indoor public settings and outdoors when distancing of 6' is not feasible. Physical distancing during organized **public gatherings (events)** is not required. Event hosts must complete a COVID-19 event plan, check for symptoms, and notify close contacts if an attendee tests positive for COVID-19. It is recommended that **social gatherings** are limited to 25 or less.
